Terms and Conditions:

- Delivery Site :** Rate are FOR Drug warehouse of JKMSCL/any Govt. Institution of J&K State, wherever installation is required.
- Validity :** The rate contract shall remain valid for a period of two years from the date of issuance of the Contract which may be extended for a period of 90 days or till such time the new rate contract is finalized, whichever is earlier, with mutual consent of JKMSCL and successful bidder.
- Taxes:** As mentioned above and as applicable.
- Warranty:** Five Years from the date of installation.
- Performance Security**
You are further required to deposit the performance security equivalent to 5% of the total invoice value in the shape of Bank Guarantee in favour of FA/CAO, JKMSCL within seven days from the date of issuance of Purchase Order(s) from time to time.
- Supplies**
Within 90 days from the date of issuance of supply order.
- Penalty**
In case In case of extension in the delivery period with liquidated damages, recovery of liquidated damages shall be made at the rate of 0.25% per day for every day of delay

subject to maximum of 10%.

8. **Installation:** Installation / commissioning and necessary training for upkeep of the equipment shall be provided free of cost.
9. **Availability of Spares:** Firm shall certify that the parts of the equipment shall remain available at least for a period of **five years** after the year of expiry of warranty period of five years.
10. You have to certify that the rates mentioned above as quoted by your firm are the lowest rates applicable to all Govt./private Institution/PSU etc. Variation found if any, during the rate contract period by the Corporation/Intending department or any other agency shall be the sole responsibility of the Contractor/Supplier/manufacturer/importer.
11. The supplier/manufacturer/importer shall ensure to supply the Brand new and unused item(s) strictly as per specifications/sample(s) approved. Variations found, if any, in instant case/or in later stages by the Corporation/Intending department/any other agency which may lead to sub standard or Not of standard/approved quality, shall be the sole responsibility of the supplier/ manufacturer/ importer/contractor.
12. JKMSCL is at liberty to get the feedback from the end-user department/intending department regarding the functioning of the machinery & equipment supplied by your agency. Adverse report, if any, may lead to strict action against you under rules/terms & conditions of the NIT/guidelines issued by the Govt. from time to time.
13. **Fall Clause:** The prices under contract shall be subject to price fall clause. The prices charged for the goods supplies under the contract by successful bidder shall in no event exceed the lowest price at which the successful bidder sells the goods or offers to sell the goods of identical description to any other person(s)/Organization(s) including procurement agencies or any other department of Central Govt. or State Govt. as the case may be during the period till the performance of the contract. If at any time, during the period of the contract, the bidder reduces the sales price chargeable under the contract, he shall forth with notify such reduction to the JKMSCL, J&K and the price payable under the contract for the stores supplied after the date of coming into force of such reduction or sale shall stand reduced correspondingly. It imply that if the contract holder quotes/ reduces its price to render similar goods at a price lower than the contract price to anyone in the Central/State Govt. at any time during the currency of contract including extension period, the contract price shall be automatically be reduced with effect from the date of reducing or quoting lower price for all delivery of subject matter of procurement under contract and the contract shall be amended accordingly.
14. **Risk Purchase :** If the bidder is unable to complete the supply within the specified or extended period, the corporation shall be entitled to purchase the goods or any part thereof from elsewhere without notice to the bidder on his (i.e., bidders) account at his cost and risk, with the prior approval of Managing Director JKMSCL, J&K. The bidder shall be liable to pay any loss or damage which the purchasing officer may sustain by reasons of such failure on the part of the bidder.
The bidder shall not be entitled to any gain on such purchases made against default. The recovery of such loss or damage shall be made from any sums accruing to the bidder under this or any other contract with the corporation/government. If recovery is not possible from the bill and the bidder fails to pay the loss or damage within one month of the demand, the recovery of such amount or sum due from the bidder shall be made from the bidder. In case supplier fails to deliver ordered goods, the risk purchases may be made at market rate from any other firm. It is mandatory for the approved supplier to acknowledge receipt of orders within seven days from the date of dispatch of order, failing which the procuring entity will be at liberty to initiate action to purchase the items on risk purchase provision at the expiry of the prescribed supply period.
15. **Orders shall only be placed on the basis of actual requirement and funds as available under the relevant Head of Accounts.**
16. **Payment shall be released after successful installation and commissioning of the equipment duly verified by the intending department.**
17. **Approved technical specifications shall remain same as per NIT (Annexure I)**

All the terms and conditions of the NIT, Standard Procurement of Procedure (SPP) of JKMSCL & LOI shall be part of this Rate Contract.

BATTERY OPERATED STERNA SAW SYSTEM

1) Vertical (Reciprocating) sternum Saw Hand Piece(Qty-2 No)

1. Should have safe mode.
2. Should have two speed controls with standard and fast mode. Free speed of 1000 to 13000 cycles per minute.
3. Weight of hand piece with battery should not be more than 3.0 lbs.
4. Microprocessor controlled Hand piece that can be calibrated for the consistence performance.
5. Should have DC brush less motor for low maintenance.
6. No lubrication requires for life time.
7. Should have Pistol grip Hand piece.
8. Should have tool less mounting of accessories for all blades or attachments.
9. Saw noise level should not more than 84 db.
10. Should be autoclavable and with different blades.
11. Should have maximum speed of 13000CPM.
12. Should be quoted with two sternum guards.

2) Redo (oscillating) Sternum saw (Qty:1 No)

1. Should have two speed controls with standard and fast mode. Free speed of 10000-12000 cycles per minute.
2. Microprocessor controlled Hand piece that can be calibrated for the consistence performance.
3. Saw noise level should not be more than 84db.
4. Weight of hand piece with battery should not be more than 3Lbs.
5. Blade mount should be adjustable to different angles with 360-degree rotation.
6. Should have tool less mounting of accessories.
7. Should have DC brush- less motor for low maintenance.
8. No lubrication for lifetime.
9. Should be autoclavable.
10. Should have safe mode.
11. Blade arc of excursion should be up to 5 degrees.

3) Battery charger with 4 batteries (Qty-1)

1. 220-240 volts and should have the feature to count the charging cycle for a particular battery.
2. Should have capability to identify the worn-out battery.
3. Should have facility to charge 4 batteries at a time without any modular modification need.
4. Should have an indicator to provide battery status for charging.
5. Should be able to check over autoclaved battery cycles. **(Number Of Time and Total Time).**
6. Should have reconditioning features for battery for NI-CD battery.
7. Should be able to charge different batteries with same charger.
8. LI-ion Cell chemistry and also compatible with Ni Mh and NI Ca batteries with low internal impedance to deliver higher current than other battery types.
9. Should be 9.9 volts with capacity of 2.2 Ah.
10. Weight should not be more than 0.9 lbs.
11. Li-Ion cell autoclavable / non- autoclavable batteries with 200 approximate & average charging cycles.
12. Should have a run time of minimum 21 minutes.
13. No need of reconditioning with no memory effect.



14. Should have indicator light to inform user of low battery life.
15. Should have capability to safety features like shuts off current to battery terminal when hand piece is not connected.

4) Sterilization Case (Qyt-2):

1. Should accommodate all hand piece, attachments and accessories for autoclave. 5)

5) Certification:

1. Should have US FDA certification or should have CE certification. 2. Should have ISO certification.

6) Service & Support:

1. The company must have their service center in India and the regional service support. 2. The company must provide a loaner support in case equipment is under warranty or under CMC.
3. Company has to provide training & education for equipment handling to all CSSD. Bio Medical & OT Staff.
4. Company must have to do minimum two-time preventive maintenance in one year, with company trained engineer.
5. Should quote for various accessories like batteries, Blades, Sternum Guard, battery case etc. which remain effective or next 3 years.
6. The company should either quote directly or through its Indian subsidiary. In case there is no Indian subsidiary, the authorized dealer only should quote the tender and should furnish proper original
